- Safety: Implementation of various measures including fire safety systems, security enhancements



- Safety and Security Enhancements








Mexico Elementary School




Capital Project Financing Plan

The total referendum authorization for the 2023 Capital Improvement project is **\$18,225,000**.

The majority of the project will be paid for using available State Building Aid funding. The remaining local share will be paid for through the District's Capital Reserve Fund, which is designated to be used specifically for capital improvements and the replacement of debt service from prior project that is retiring. The project referendum amount includes all costs to design, renovate, construct and furnish facilities as necessary.

As a result of careful planning and budget implementation, the proposed project will have **NO ADDITIONAL TAX INCREASE** for the district residents and businesses.
